Dear Parent/Guardian,

Sexually transmitted diseases (STDs) are a growing health problem for teenagers in Kalamazoo County. Kalamazoo County ranks in the top 10 for Chlamydia and Gonorrhea in Michigan. Chlamydia, gonorrhea, and other STDs often have no symptoms. The only way most people know they are infected is if they get tested. Left untreated, STDs can cause serious damage that can make it hard or even impossible to have children in the future. **Having an STD also makes it easier to get or spread HIV.**

Concerned about the future health of young people in our community; Kalamazoo County Health & Community Services and Gateway Academy is offering an STD education and testing program for all students on Friday, March 11. *Taking the STD test is totally voluntary*. During our program, students learn about STDs, including how to prevent them, and then have the opportunity to take a **free urine test** for chlamydia and gonorrhea. Anyone who tests positive for either infection receives **free treatment** – a single dose of antibiotics: Azithromycin (Zithromax) and/or Ceftriaxone (Rocephin). All test results and treatment records are confidential. As required by law only the student, neither the school nor parent has access to this information.

All students can benefit from this program! Whether or not they choose to be tested, they all get important health information to help prevent STDs in the future.
